RECIPE SWAP Butternut Pudding

Ingredients

2 – 10 ounce packages frozen butternut squash puree

1 – 14 ounce can of coconut milk

4 eggs

1/2 cup pure maple syrup whipped cream

Directions

Preheat oven to 325 degrees. Thaw squash and blend with coconut milk, eggs and syrup; pour into 8-inch baking dish. Put dish in roasting pan; pour boiling water halfway up dish to make water bath. Bake, 1 hour. Top with cream.


